The **2010 Sandbach Transport Festival** will be held over a two day period and feature various aspects of transport of all ages, from bicycles to Commercial Vehicles. On **Sunday 18th April**, entrants are invited to participate in a parade of approximately 2 miles around the town with public viewing before and after the parade. The parade will use a route agreed with the authorities and is therefore classed as 'locked'. As vehicles will use public highways during the parade, motor vehicles will require statutory insurance and for other vehicles, public liability cover may be required. Proof of insurance cover may be asked for prior or during the event.

Because of the limitation of space, numbers are restricted, therefore the sooner you reply, the more certain you will be of your entry's acceptance. Submission of an entry form does not guarantee acceptance, but all those accepted or refused will be notified 3 to 6 weeks before the event date. **For this event the administration charge will be waived.**

Please complete **ALL THE PARTS OVERLEAF** and return it to **M.R Marshall, Sandbach Transport Festival, 36 Roman Way, Sandbach, Cheshire. CW11 3EW.** by 31st January at the latest. Entries can be accepted after this date, but entries received prior to the closing date will take precedence. All entrants receive a commemorative plaque. **The organisers reserve the right to refuse incomplete entries, limit multiple applications and if required, amend the programme.** All communications will be by post. These notes must be complied with if your entry is to be considered.

PART 2. TYPE OF VEHICLE.

Please indicate the type of vehicle that you wish to enter. **Class A This class has been withdrawn from this event.** **Class B** covers all bicycles, tricycles, velocipedes and other similar machines, as well as motorcycles, including those with sidecars and trailers. **Class C** covers all motor cars and light vans, whether used commercially or not, and not exceeding 1.5 metric tons in weight. **Class D** covers all road locomotives [traction engines]. **Class E** covers all goods vehicles over 1.5 metric tons and includes buses, large military vehicles and similar machines. **Class F** covers all tractors and powered agricultural equipment such as combine harvesters and similar vehicles. For any vehicle or machine not included above, or you are unsure of which class your vehicle belongs to, mark the **Class G box** and a decision on the class of vehicle and entry fee [if applicable] will be made. For single animals or groups of people [bands etc] please apply for **Parade Processions, Form [F36A016]**, or if you wish to enter a carnival vehicle or float, please apply for **Entrant Application – Carnival Vehicles [F36A017]**. Tick the appropriate box and the application forms and a pre-paid envelope for reply will be sent to you.

A, B, & D. Please fill in the details of your vehicle as requested. **C. Index No.** Please enter the registration number if applicable. **E. Remember to include any trailer or equipment that the vehicle may be towing as part of your entry. **Vehicles which attend that are larger than the stated measurements may be re-allocated or excluded from the marshalling area.** **F. PARKING.** If you are bringing your vehicle by trailer, low loader or transporter, please fill in the dimensions of the transporting vehicle so that arrangements can be made to secure parking arrangements for that vehicle on a reserved vehicle park.

As a responsible organiser, it is incumbent on the committee to ensure that vehicles are covered by insurance during the event, particularly during the parade as vehicles will be using the public highway and in some cases using carriageways with unrestricted oncoming traffic. Upon acceptance of your application, you will be sent the Final Instructions.

For multiple entries from clubs, organisations or companies please indicate your consent from the owners of the vehicles by stating your capacity to act on their behalf, such as entry secretary and indicate the number of entries you have included.
